

Kanyarat Petcharat 2020 : The Effect Of Analyzing factors affecting retirement Planning in Thailand with Population in Bangkok. Master of Arts, Major Field: Applied Finance, Independent Study Advisor: Associate Professor Pattaragit Netiniyom, Ph.d. 89 pages.

The study of the analyzing factors affecting planning for retirement is the quantitative research uses survey research. The used tools are online questionnaires. The sample consists of 400 person in Bangkok. Statistics used in data analysis include descriptive statistics including frequency distribution, percentage, mean value and standard deviation. The inferential statistics apply on Chi-square tests.

The study found two major outcomes. (1) Opinions on planning for preparation of retirement in general is uncertain criteria. When considering the example found that the first priority was mind and body is the criteria agreement followed by perception of preparation for retirement.

The recognition of retirement preparation through economy and politics and social and family ranked is uncertain criteria, respectively. (2) The hypothesis testing found that education level, status, occupation and monthly income is a variable that is related to retirement planning is the overall and individual aspects with statistical significance at the level of 0.05.
